## **School Uniform**

We would also encourage you not to send your child into school with expensive items, such as coats, shoes, bags, etc., to avoid the risk of wear and tear, loss or damage to costly items. The Academy cannot be held liable for the replacement cost of students' personal belongings which are lost or damaged at school, including items which are optionally expensive choices.

### Caffeinated, Fizzy and Energy Drinks

I would like to remind parents and carers that drinks which are caffeinated, fizzy or classed as energy drinks are not allowed in school at any time. These are full of sugar and research shows that energy drinks can cause headaches, stomach aches, anxiety, sleep disruption and other harmful side effects to children. We recommend that students drink water at school and there are several filtered water dispensers situated throughout the building where students can refill their personal water bottles during social time, free of charge.

# **Family Holidays during Term Time**

There have been a number of requests recently for permission to take students out of school for family holidays. DfE guidance permits headteachers to grant leave of absence only in exceptional circumstances however family holidays are not considered to be exceptional circumstances. Please be aware that requests for holidays taken during term time will not be authorised, i.e. recorded as unauthorised absence, in line with DfE and Rochdale Local Authority guidelines. Therefore, any parents and carers who choose to do this will incur financial penalties imposed by the Local Authority.
