Dear Parent/Carer

As your children come to the end of their time at St Anne's Academy, may I take the opportunity to thank you and to thank them for all their hard work over the years. Over the five years I have been impressed with their character, sense of community and they have worked positively throughout the year.

Firstly, school for Year 11 will finish on Wednesday 14th June after their morning exam. We will hold a celebratory final assembly for them, and they will be dismissed between 11:50 and 12.05pm. There is no requirement for them to attend timetabled lessons after this time. However, from Thursday 15th June we are holding revision sessions for pupils which they can attend. If your child attends, then they are required to wear full school uniform and come in for those sessions only. It is important that we support the success of Year 11 without having a negative impact on the learning of others.

Secondly, I still expect all pupils to sit their exams in their full school uniform. I have key reasons for this in that it ensures they focus on their work and not on what they are wearing; it maintains a calm, purposeful and orderly environment around the school; it ensures they remain part of the St Anne's community.

Finally, your child should have a copy of this letter that includes the revision session timetable, it is also attached to this letter which will be available on our website.

Sitting GCSEs can be an intense experience for all the family. I advise the pupils to revise regularly for short amounts of time, to take breaks and to make sure they are hydrated. They do have to work hard but, as always, if you are worried about your child, please don't hesitate to contact any one of us at school.
