Walking



ROAI

- Walk carefully, sensibly and considerately on footpaths and pavements; Do not walk or run in the road
- Always cross the road safely and at designated permitted places use the pelican crossings on Hollin Lane and the pedestrian island on Hazelhurst Road to help you cross
- Follow the 'Green Cross Code': Think; Stop; Look and Listen; Wait; Look and Listen again; Arrive alive!
 - Think! Find the safest place to cross
 - Stop! Stand on the pavement near the kerb not on the road
 - Look and Listen! Look all around for traffic and listen
 - Wait! Until it is safe to cross. Don't rush, if traffic is coming, let it pass.
 - Look and listen again!

- Don't talk to strangers and walk with friends if possible
- Take extra care walking during Autumn and Winter months and be visible

- Devices can be a major distraction, so put them away and take any headphones out while crossing the road

Cycling



- Ride your bike carefully, sensibly and considerately on the road or in designated cycle paths / tracks / lanes
- Cycle on the correct side of the road and respect other road users don't jump red lights
- Do not cycle on footpaths or pavements and signal clearly where you are going
- Always wear a cycle helmet to protect your head if you fall off or have an accident
- Always wear a cycle heimer to protect your nead if you fail on or have an accident



- Make sure you are visible your bike should have a white light at the front and a red light at the back as well as reflectors that's the law!
- Follow the Highway Code for cyclists
- Check out 'Brake' or 'Sustrans' for more cycling tips
- Use a good quality bike lock or chain to secure your bike to keep your bike safe in school

By Bus



- Behave appropriately at all times, and follow the TfGM Behaviour Code, on and off the Bus and while you are waiting at the bus stop
- Stay in your seat
- Don't distract the Driver, and follow their instructions
- Don't do anything to endanger yourself or others

By Car



Try to get dropped off away from the school site to avoid congestion
